

We will begin the second lecture on the Study of Evangelism. /The main verse we will look at is Mark 16:15. /Read Mark 16:15. /He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the good news to all creation."

/Jesus said, /"Go into all the world /and preach the good news /to all creation."

/Chapter 2, Why Must We Evangelize? We will prove why we must evangelize. /Jesus said, "Go into all the world /and preach the good news to all creation." /This means that we must transcend all race /and transcend all ethnic groups, /and preach the gospel to the many souls in this world.

/We must evangelize because /1. it is Jesus' command. /Jesus personally gave this command. /Jesus resurrected to life /and left these words before He ascended into heaven. /Why did God establish the church, /why did he establish seminaries, /and why did God send missionaries?

/It was so that we would obey the Lord's command. /Why did the Helper Holy Spirit come to us? /It was so that we would obey Jesus' command. /Jesus gave us an absolute command.

/"Preach the gospel. /"Preach whether you have the chance to or not." /"Preach the gospel to all nations and peoples." /Believers who have been saved /must obey this command. /This is not something that we have the choice to do or not do, /but it is the Lord's absolute command.

/We will have no choice but to receive judgment before God if we disobey Jesus' command. /When we obey and preach the gospel, /the church will be blessed /and we too will be blessed. /Today, there are many people in this world who have been chosen by God.

/Who must they share the gospel with? /Jesus commanded us. /We must pray together when we gather in the church, /and we must evangelize when we each return to our lives.

/The places where you live your lives /must turn into places of evangelism. /Why did God send me to this company? /Why did God make me meet this person? /God made us meet certain people so that we would share the gospel with them.

/There is a married couple in our church. /One day, the wife spoke to her husband. /"I had many chances to marry pastors /before I married you." /"However, I did not marry them." /The wife wanted to save her unbelieving husband. /Her husband said, "I went to church and I was saved through you."

/We must obey God's command and return to our places, /and we must share the gospel with many others. /Jesus personally gave this command. /The Lord commanded that we go into all the world and preach the gospel to all peoples.

/Is it okay to disobey this command? /The church must also obey this command. /The church must diligently evangelize in places nearby, /and the church must bring up pastors and send out missionaries.

/We must sacrifice materials /and sacrifice our time /in order to obey this command. /Lastly, we must sacrifice our lives to obey this command.

/Next, why must we evangelize? /2. Evangelism is the act of loving Jesus. John 14:15; 2 Corinthians 5:14. /It says, "If you love me, you will obey what I command." /Those who love the Lord /have the Lord's heart.

/What is the Lord's heart? /It is the heart that saves souls. /Jesus preached the gospel to many people on this earth. /If we truly love Jesus, /we must obey the Lord's command and evangelize.

/Anyone who is loved by another person listens well to that person. /If we truly love the Lord, /we must obey the Lord's word /and share the gospel with many others. /What is the heart of the Lord?

/God does not want anyone to perish, /no matter how many sins one may have committed in the past. /God wants them to repent, believe in Jesus, and be saved. /We must know the Lord's heart, /and we must diligently evangelize.

/The Lord first loved us, /and He gave us conditions and environments where we could evangelize. /If we love the Lord, /we must walk where He walked, /have a heart like His, and share the gospel.

/What is another reason why we must evangelize? /Why did the Lord tell us to evangelize? /3. Jesus came to this earth to personally evangelize. /Mark 1:38 says, /Jesus prayed early in the morning /and evangelized in villages.

/What did the Lord say? /"That is why I have come." /Jesus laid down His glory and throne in heaven, /came to this lowly world, /saved the dying, /healed the sick, /and saved God's people.

/Jesus came to this world to save the lost sheep. /Jesus personally showed us an example of evangelism. /Jesus laid down all glory in heaven to evangelize. /Jesus sacrificed His life to evangelize.

/Jesus became humble to evangelize. /Jesus prayed diligently to God to evangelize. /Jesus performed miracles with the authority of God to evangelize.

/Jesus personally showed us an example, /and He commanded us to evangelize as well. /Jesus personally evangelized, /and hence, we too must follow the Lord and carry out our calling of evangelism.

/Jesus personally carried out the calling of evangelism /and He brought up disciples /and us as well, /so that we would preach the gospel. /Luke 19:10 says, /Jesus came to seek and save what was lost.

/Jesus met Zacchaeus and said, “Today salvation has come to this house.” /Zacchaeus was lost. /He was a tax collector /and was rich in the world. /However, he did not know heaven and he did not know Jesus.

/Zacchaeus thought that he would be happy if he was rich. /However, he needed to believe in Jesus. /When Zacchaeus wanted to meet Jesus, /he could not see Him because he was too short.

/He climbed up a sycamore-fig tree and looked down at Jesus, /and Jesus said to him, /“Zacchaeus, come down immediately.” /Zacchaeus must have been surprised when Jesus called him by name.

/How does He know my name? /Then Jesus said, /“I must stay at your house today.” /Zacchaeus came down at once and welcomed Jesus into his home. /Jesus proclaimed, /“Today salvation has come to this house.”

/The Lord then said to Zacchaeus, “This man, too, is a son of Abraham.” /Jesus saved Zacchaeus, /who was rich in the world, /greedy, /and didn’t know God.

/The Lord said, “I came to seek and to save what was lost.” /Jesus came to this earth to seek the lost sheep. /Jesus went from place to place to seek lost sheep.

/Jesus, the Son of God, evangelized, /and so shouldn’t we evangelize as well? /Failing to evangelize is disobedience to Jesus /and we will grow far from the Lord.

/Jesus personally evangelized, /and He told us to preach the gospel. /Jesus’ evangelism transcended all races and peoples. /Jesus shared the gospel with the poor, /the Jews, /and the Gentiles.

/Jesus carried the world in his heart and preached the gospel. /We too must diligently evangelize as Jesus did. /Today, people who are to be saved are waiting for us all around the world.

/There are people nearby and people far away /who need to believe in Jesus and be saved. /Who must save those who are to go to hell? /Jesus personally preached the gospel /and He commanded us to do the same.

/What is another reason why we must evangelize? /4. Evangelism comes from love for other’s souls. John 5:24; Romans 5:12. /The Bible emphasizes love. /“Love God.” /“Love your neighbors as yourselves.”

/What is the greatest love for one’s neighbor? /Is the giving of bread love? /Is physical

help love? /Is temporary help for a person in need love? /They are certainly ways we can love others.

/However, what is the most noble love? /The best kind of love is to share the gospel and guide someone to heaven. /God emphasized love for our neighbors. /We must love our neighbors.

/One way to love our neighbors /is to evangelize and save their souls. /The apostle Paul loved his people. /Paul wanted his people to be saved /even if he was cursed at and destroyed.

/Do you love your people? /You must share the gospel with your people. /Do you love your brothers and sisters? /If so, you must guide them to heaven so that they do not go to hell.

/If someone you love is drowning in water, what will you do? /If someone we love is drowning, we will not simply stand and watch. /We will risk our lives and jump into the water /to save the person we love.

/We must have burning hearts for souls. /We evangelize when we truly love others. /Today, we must love all peoples of the world. /There are many, many souls in this world.

/They are all precious who have been created in God's image. /Why did God tell us to love our neighbors? /Each person has a spirit that was made in the image of God. /God created man spiritually, /but there are many poor souls that do not know God.

/We must have compassion on them and share the gospel. /Who are the most unfortunate people in the world? /Are they people who do not have money? /Are they people who are uneducated? /Are they people who are poor? /The most unfortunate people in this world are those who do not know Jesus. /The poorest people in the world are those who do not believe in Jesus and head towards hell.

/We must love each and every person, /and we must share the gospel with them. /Who will save them from hell /if I don't share the gospel with them? /We received the Lord's unending love.

/We must burn with love in our hearts /and we must share the Lord's love with others. /The most important part of practicing love is saving other's souls. /Evangelism is the way of leading others to God, /leading others to heaven, /and leading others to repentance of sins and eternal life.

/Do you love your families? /You must evangelize to them so that they all believe in Jesus. /Do you love your people? /You must preach the gospel to your nations. /Do you love the souls in this world?

/We must evangelize to many others so that we can practice love. /We must always

remember in our hearts that /the best way to practice love is to evangelize and lead others to heaven.

/Why else must we evangelize? /5. We must evangelize because unbelievers will perish if we don't do anything. John 3:36. /Anyone who does not know God /or Jesus /will die if we let them be.

/John 8:24 says, /"If you do not believe that I am the one I claim to be, you will indeed die in your sins." /Whoever does not believe in Jesus will be slaves to sin and the devil, /and then their souls will perish. Therefore, we must share the gospel with them.

/If man does not solve the problem of sin, he will encounter death as a result of his sins. /What is the fundamental problem that man must solve in his life? /It is the problem of sin. /If man does not solve the problem of sin, he will die.

/His physical body will die, /and he will spend eternity in hell because his spirit will be dead. /Let's say that you are walking down the street /and you see a child drowning in water. /If you have a conscience, /you would go and save the child from drowning.

/However, if anyone simply passes on by even after he sees the child, /he would be a person without a conscience /and a very wicked person. /He would also receive judgment before God.

/If a child is drowning and is about to die, can we just walk past the child? /We must go down to the water and save the child. /Today, there are many people around us who are like the drowning child.

/There are many people who do not know God and who are lost. /There are many people who lost direction and are in search for something. /There are many people around us who are walking down the road of destruction in their sins. /They will die if we let them be.

/Who must save them? /We must evangelize and save them. /If we truly have a conscience, /we must save people on the road of destruction in their sins, /just as we would save a drowning child.

/We must not let them be. /Jesus did not want them to perish. /Jesus commanded us to evangelize so that they would gain life /and walk down the road to eternal life.

/Why else must we evangelize? /6. There is no other way to salvation than through Jesus. /Acts 4:12 says, /"Salvation is found in no one else." /Today, there are many religions in the world.

/However, salvation is found in no other religion. /One can only be saved if he believes in Jesus. /Why is Jesus alone our Savior? /Jesus died on the cross because of our sins, /and He paid the price for our sins. /The Lord also rose back to life in three days.

/Jesus is the Mediator between God and us, /and He is our Savior. /When Jesus was born, the angel of the Lord gave Him the name Jesus. /His name was “Jesus.” /What does “Jesus” mean?

/It means, “He will save his people from their sins.” /There is no other salvation in this whole world. /No one can be saved through cult leaders or by names of famous people. /We cannot be saved by famous people on earth. /Jesus alone is our Savior.

/Therefore, we must preach Jesus to many souls. /We must preach, “You will be saved if you believe in Jesus,” /to people of other religions. /We receive forgiveness of sins through Jesus, /become God’s children through Jesus, /and enter heaven through Jesus.

/Our prayers can be answered when we pray in Jesus’ name. /People do not know how precious Jesus is. /Jesus alone is the true Savior and our Messiah, and therefore, we must evangelize.

/We must preach Jesus to the poor, /and we must preach Jesus to the rich. /We must testify about Jesus to the powerful people in the world. /The apostle Paul gave up his life to preach about Jesus.

/Paul preached about Jesus to many souls. /Paul preached about Jesus even when he was in prison, /and he preached about Jesus even before the king. /The apostle Paul prayed to God in prison at Philippi, /and he experienced a miracle from God when he came out of the prison.

/The prison guards were afraid at the time. /If prison guards failed to guard the prison, there was the chance that they might be killed. /The prison guards’ lives were at stake. /They spoke to Paul. /“What must we do to be saved?”

/Then Paul preached about Jesus. /“Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved — you and your household.” /We must diligently preach about Jesus because there is no other way to salvation than through Jesus. /There are many cults in this world today.

/We must first reach out and preach about Jesus /before cults lead others down the wrong way first.

/Why else must we evangelize? /7. People hear and believe only when we evangelize. /Romans 10:14. /“How can they hear without someone preaching to them?” /God said that we must preach so that others can be saved.

/When we diligently evangelize, /there are people who listen. /The moment they hear the gospel, the Holy Spirit instantly touches their heart so that they believe. /The church’s calling is to sound the trumpet of the gospel. /We must diligently preach whether people listen to us or don’t.

/Faith comes from hearing the message. Romans 10:17. /God's people must sound the trumpet of the gospel. /Today, the church's calling is to sound the trumpet of the gospel. /We must diligently share the gospel with our brothers and sisters.

/We need patience when we evangelize. /We must not be disheartened because people do not believe right away. /We must have patience and continue to preach. /Our job is to preach.

/Why else must we evangelize? /8. We are obligated to preach the gospel. /Romans 1:14. We are under obligation to the gospel. /We received evangelism from others. /When we evangelize to others, we fulfill our obligation to the gospel.

/How can we preach the gospel to many others to fulfill our obligation? /The gospel does not belong only to us. /If we received the gospel, we must now share it with others.

/The believers accepted the gospel in the times of the early church, /and they gained life through God's word, /were changed, /and changed the world. /We must start with places nearby to fulfill our obligation to the gospel. /We must also carry out the calling of missions.

/We must fulfill our obligation to the gospel by preaching the gospel to the ends of the earth. /The apostle Paul encountered numerous hardships and sufferings, /and even laid down his life /to fulfill his obligation to the gospel. /Paul shared the gospel with the Jews and with the Gentiles /to fulfill his obligation to the gospel.

/Why else must we evangelize? /9. There is woe if we do not evangelize. /1 Corinthians 9:16. /God extended our lives so that we would evangelize, /and God poured out his grace and blessings on us.

/The Lord gave us his grace and blessings, /and if we do not preach the gospel, there will be woe.

/If we do not share the gospel, God's punishment and woe will be on us. /Why did God give us materials? /God gave us materials so that we would use them for the gospel. /If we use our materials to save lives, God will continue to bless us.

/Why did God give us health? /God gave us health so that we would preach the gospel.

/Why else must we evangelize? /10. There will be rewards when we evangelize. /Daniel 12:13 says, /"Those who lead many to righteousness, /like the stars for ever and ever" they will shine.

/Everyone who believes in Jesus will go to heaven. /However, some will receive rewards in God's kingdom, and some will not receive rewards. /If we evangelize to many people, /we will receive crowns in God's kingdom, /and we will shine like stars forever and ever.

/How many times have you evangelized to others? /Those who evangelize will not only receive rewards in God's kingdom, /but will receive blessings on earth.

/Why else must we evangelize? /11. Our faith grows when we evangelize. /When we share the gospel with others, our faith grows beautifully. /When we share the gospel, we will gain confidence in our salvation.

/When we share the gospel with others, God's power and authority will be upon us. /When the disciples went out to evangelize, /Jesus sent them out /with power and authority. /There is power in those who diligently evangelize, /but there is no power in those who do not evangelize.

/There will be many advantages when we evangelize. /When we save others, we live as well.

/Why else must we evangelize? /12. It pleases God most when we evangelize. /Luke 15:7. /"I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents /than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent."

/Jesus came to find the lost. /God is very happy when the lost are found. /God is pleased when we use our materials when we evangelize. /God is pleased when we use our time to evangelize.

/Use all aspects of your lives /to please God. /God will then provide you with an abundance of more things.
